In celebration of National Historic Preservation Month, a walking tour in Mānoa Valley will be held to benefit the community organization, Mālama o Mānoa.

Visitors will walk the 1-1/2 mile route through the neighborhoods of McKinley Street, Kakela Drive, Haena Drive and Rocky Hill Place. Seven homes will be open and another 20 other historic homes and sites

will be featured. Check-in/on-site registration for these self-guided tours begin at 8:30 a.m. with the last tour leaving at 10:30 a.m.
